Highlights:

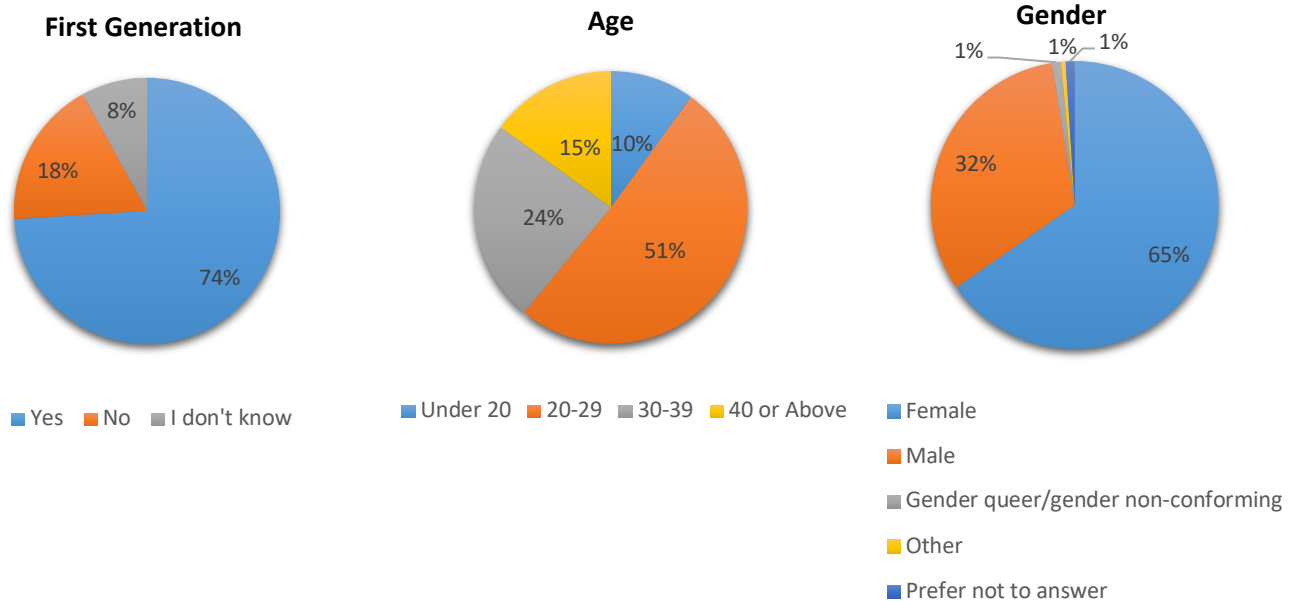
- One simplified scholarship application process for students, faculty, and staff
